



## Clearing Cookies in Internet Explorer

1. In the top right corner, click on the  symbol.
2. Choose **Internet Options** near the bottom of the dropdown list.
3. From the Internet Options pop-up menu, make sure you are on the **General** Tab. Browsing history appears near the bottom of that selection.
4. Check the **Delete browsing history** on exit box in the Browsing history section.
5. Then click **Delete**.




6. Select **Cookies and website data** on the Delete Browsing History pop-up menu.




7. Click **Delete**
8. You'll receive a message stating, "Internet Explorer has completed deleting the selected browsing history" when it is finished.

## Clearing Cookies in Firefox

1. Click on the  button in the top right corner of the browser.
2. Select **Options** from the menu.
3. Select **Privacy** from the left-hand menu.




4. Under the History section of the selected Privacy page, click on **remove individual cookies**.
5. On the Cookie pop-up menu, select **Remove All** at the bottom.




6. Then click **Close** when it is finished deleting.

## Clearing Cookies in Google Chrome

1. Click on the  button in the top right corner of the browser.
2. Select **History**.
3. On the History page, select the **Clear browsing data** button.



4. On the Clear browsing data pop-up menu, check Cookies and other site and plugin data.



5. Then click **Clear browsing data**.
6. Click out of the menu when you are finished.
