Clearing Cookies in Internet Explorer

- 1. In the top right corner, click on the 🔯 symbol.
- 2. Choose Internet Options near the bottom of the dropdown list.
- 3. From the Internet Options pop-up menu, make sure you are on the **General** Tab. Browsing history appears near the bottom of that selection.
- 4. Check the **Delete browsing history** on exit box in the Browsing history section.
- 5. Then click **Delete**.
